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## OTHER HEALTH IMPAIRMENT

Other Health Impairment means having limited strength, vitality or alertness, including a heightened alertness to environmental stimuli, that results in limited alertness with respect to the educational environment, that is due to chronic or acute health problems such as a heart condition, tuberculosis, rheumatic fever, nephritis, arthritis, asthma, sickle cell anemia, hemophilia, epilepsy, lead poisoning, leukemia, attention deficit disorder or attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, and diabetes; and adversely affects a child's educational performance.

### Checklist for Determining Eligibility:

- Evidence of a chronic or acute health impairment
  
- Documentation of limited strength, vitality, or alertness, including a heightened sensitivity to environmental stimuli, that results in limited alertness with respect to the educational environment
  
- Documentation, when possible, of a decline in strength, vitality, or alertness after the onset of the health impairment
  
- Documentation of an adverse effect on the child's educational performance
  - If adverse effect is related to the presence of ADD/HD refer to documentation form attached for determination criteria
  
- Documentation of an adverse educational impact and the need for special education/related services
